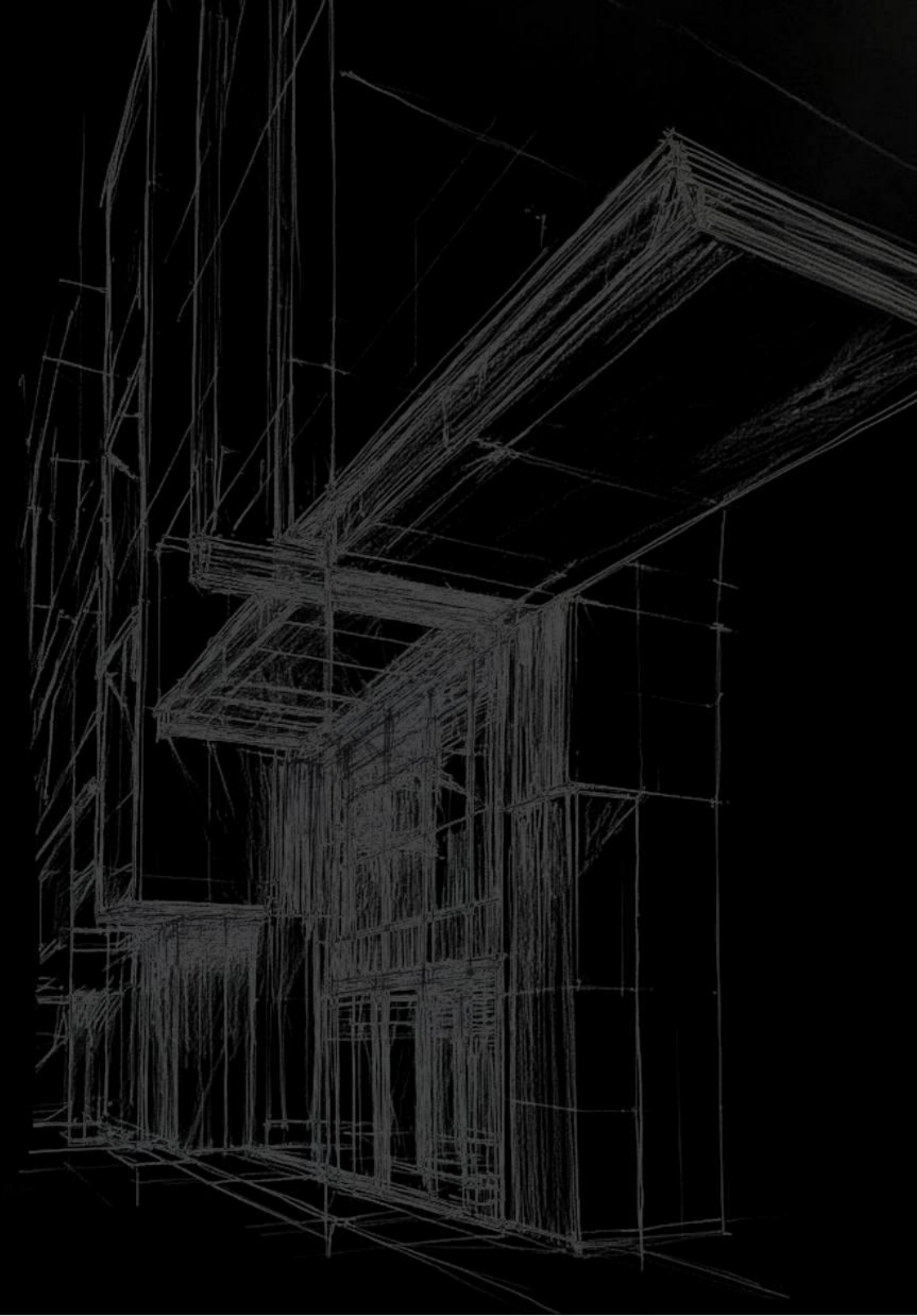

Located on a unique D-shaped sea-facing plot, the design was inspired by the fluid nature of water and ocean waves.

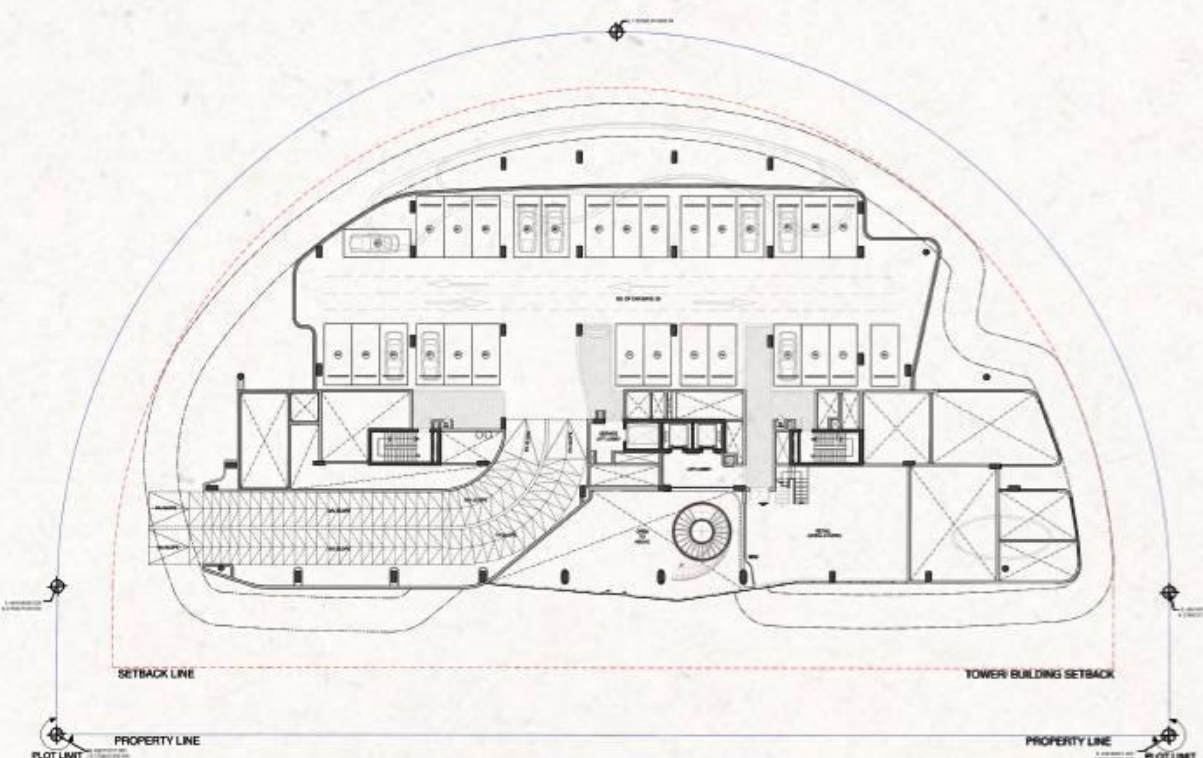
Care was also taken to avoid overly symmetrical geometry, creating a more natural and dynamic architectural and interior expression.



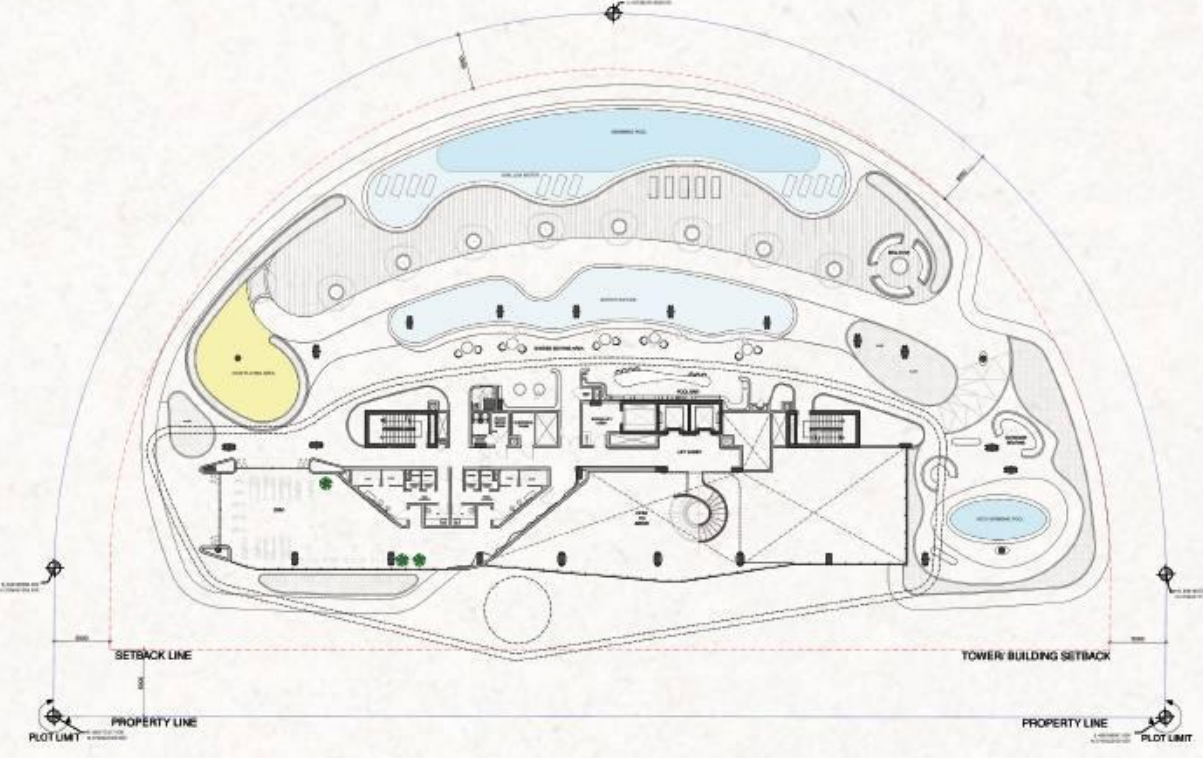

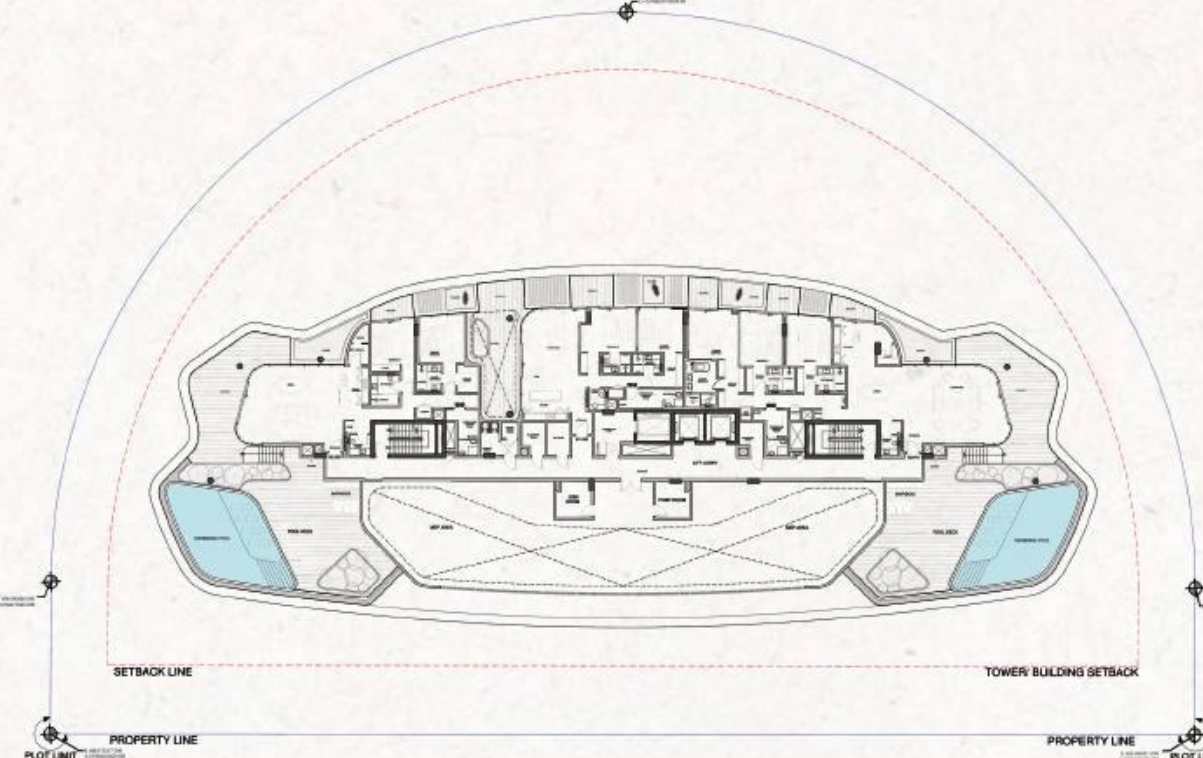

PROJECT BRIEF :

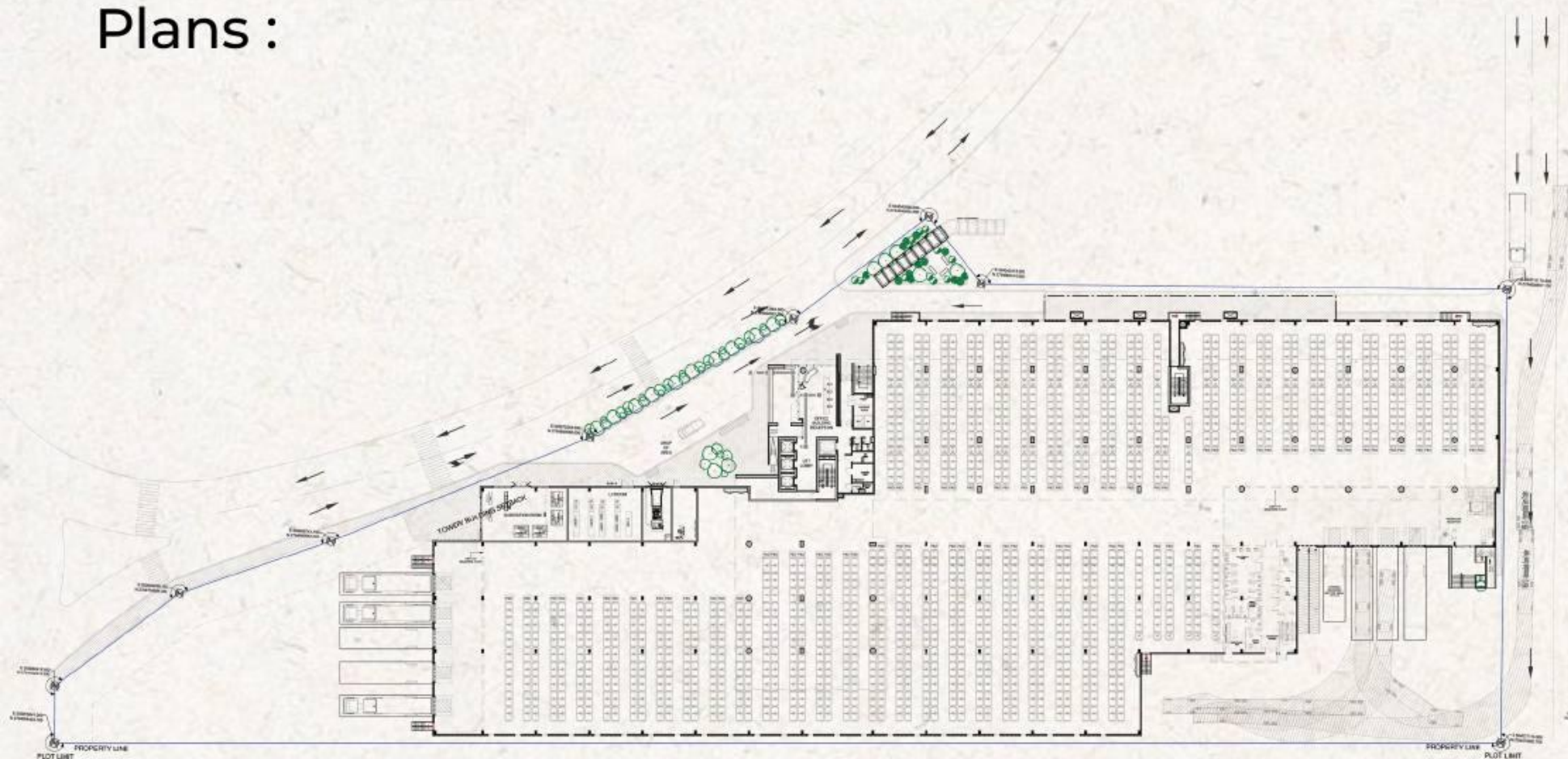
Located adjacent to Dubai Airport, this project was envisioned as a mixed-use commercial development.

In collaboration with the senior architects, a dual-purpose complex was proposed, comprising a ground-floor warehouse and a five-storey office building above.

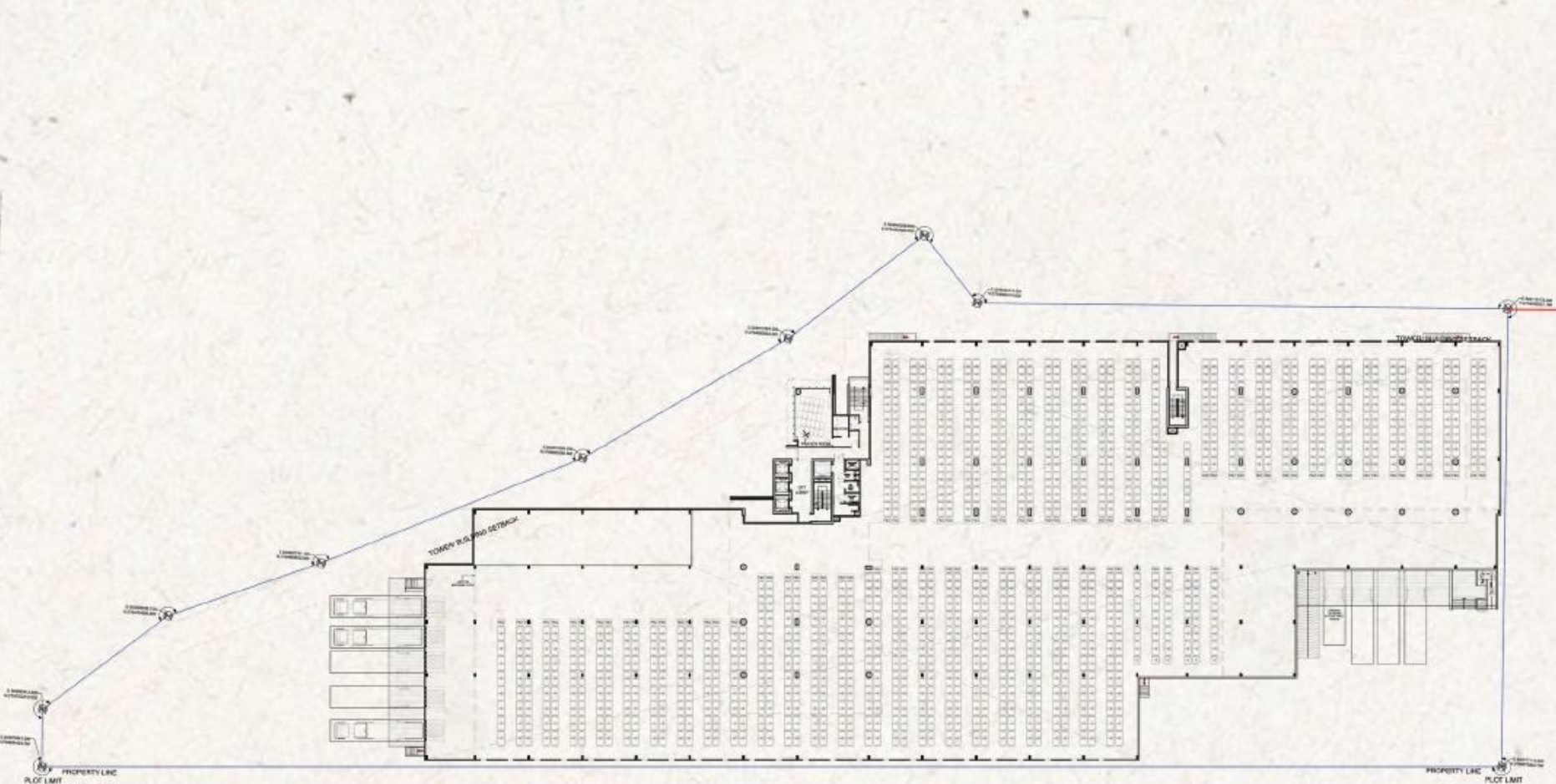
Both components were designed as leasable spaces for third-party tenants, maximizing the site's commercial value while ensuring efficient functionality and long-term flexibility.



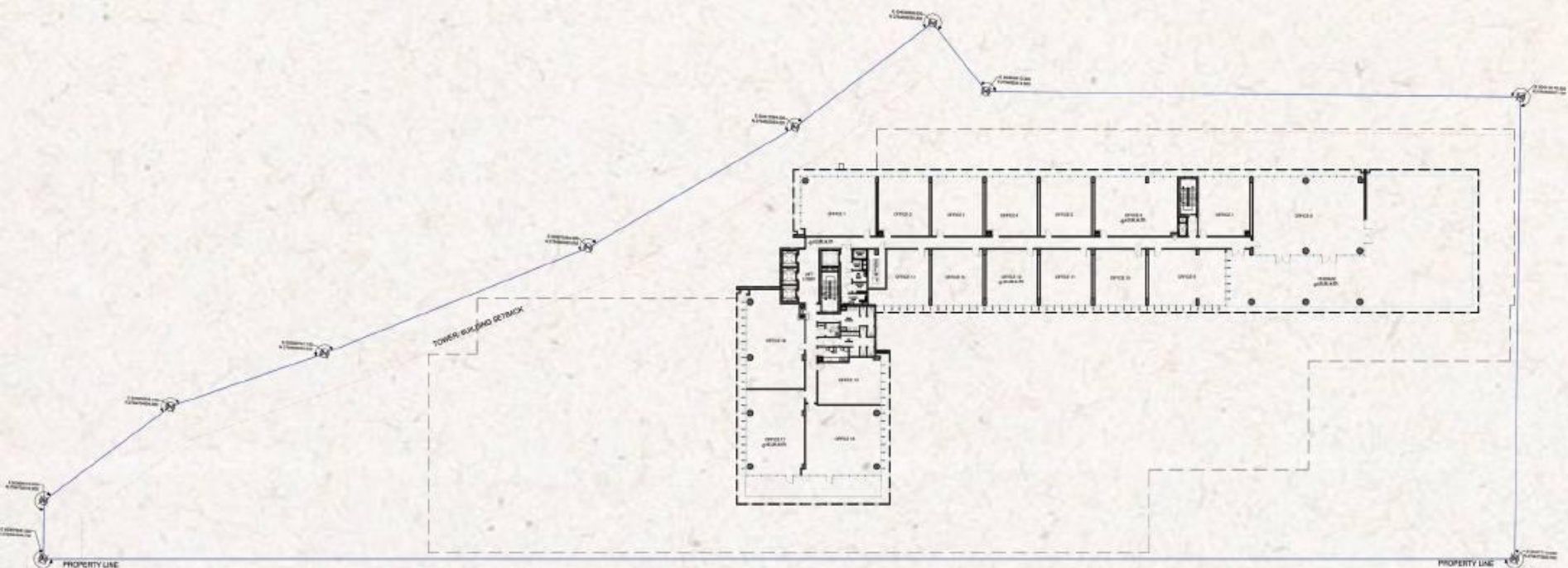

The project involved the redevelopment of the existing Gold Souq area while preserving and integrating the existing landscape.

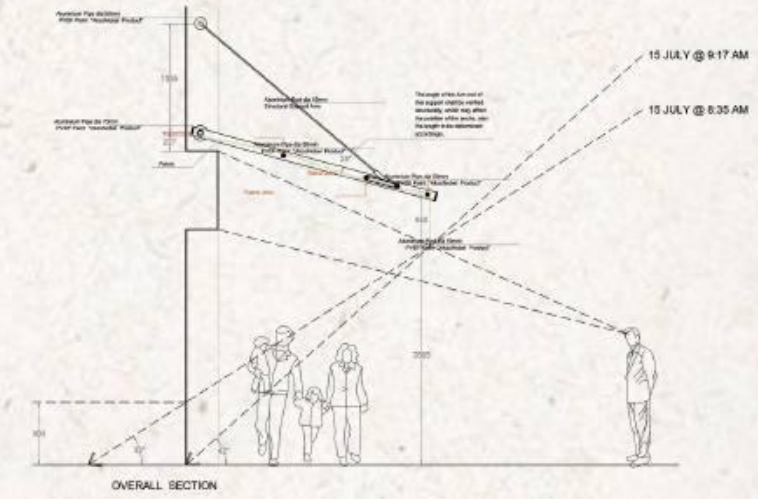
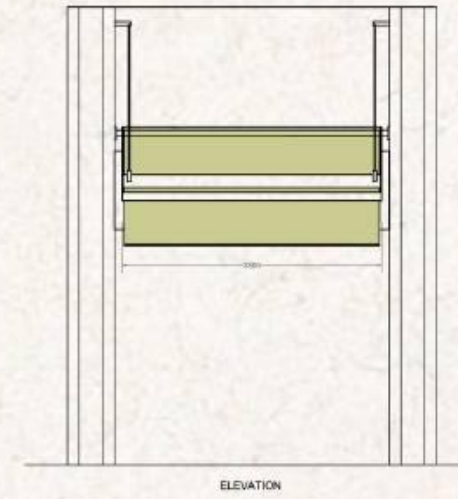
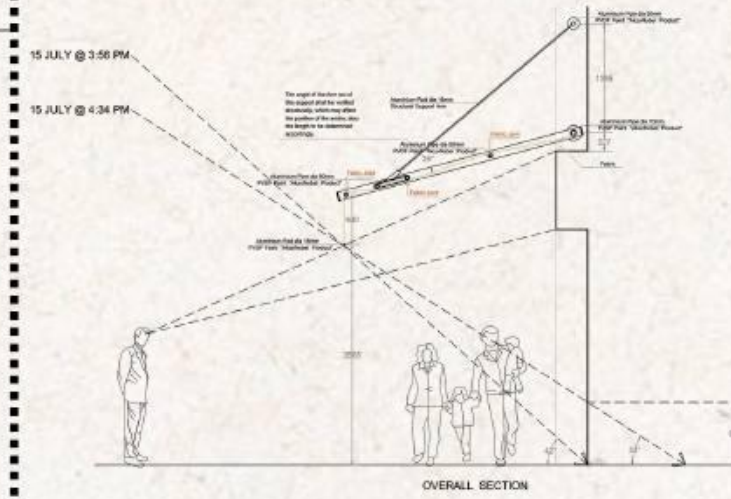
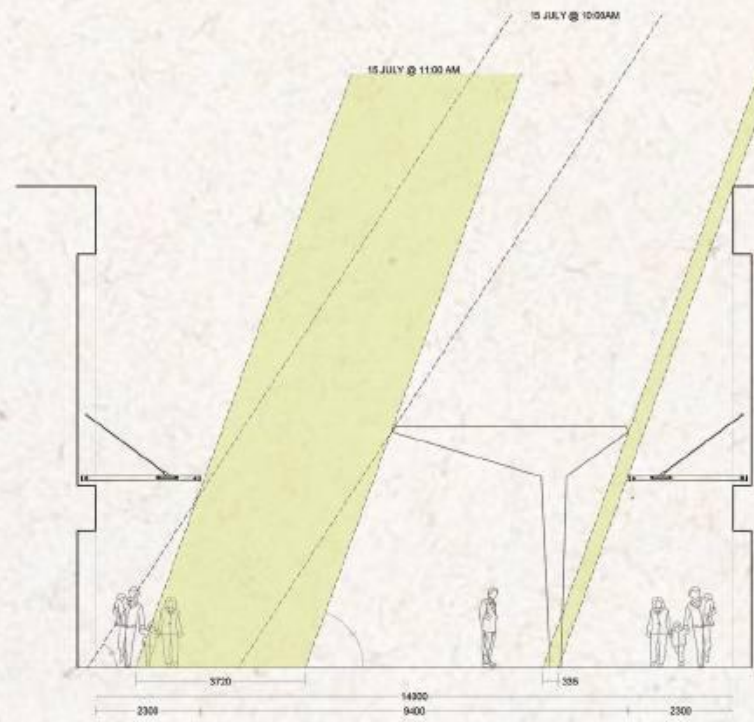
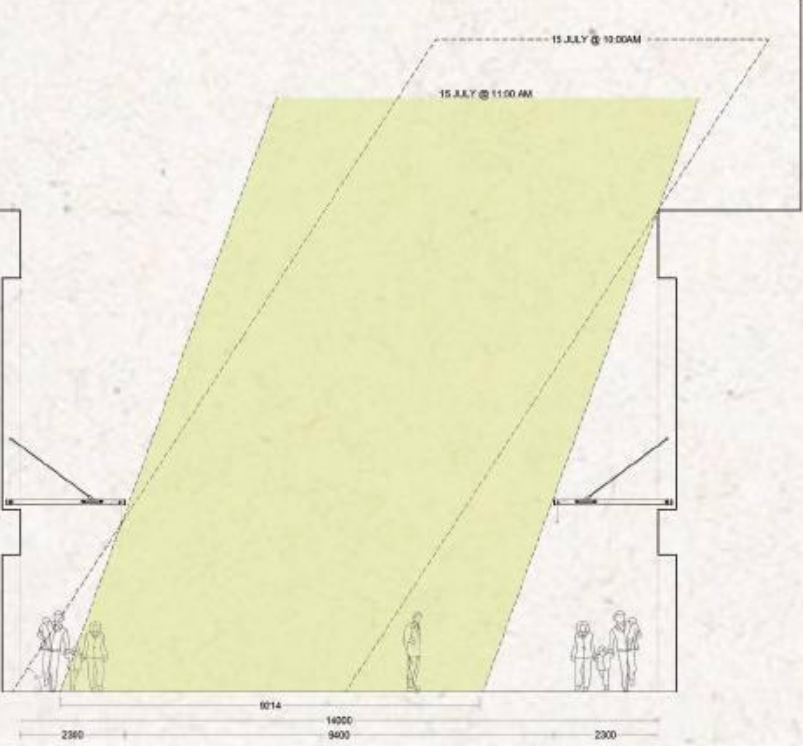
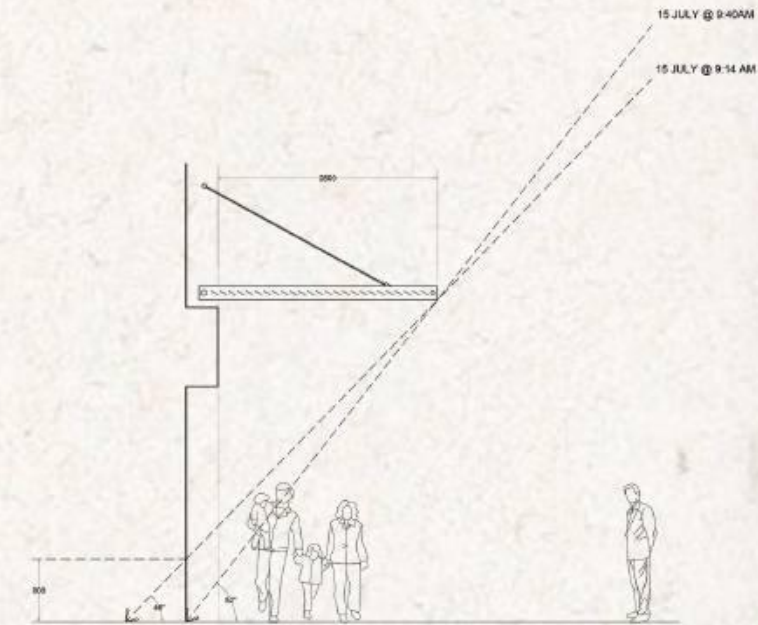
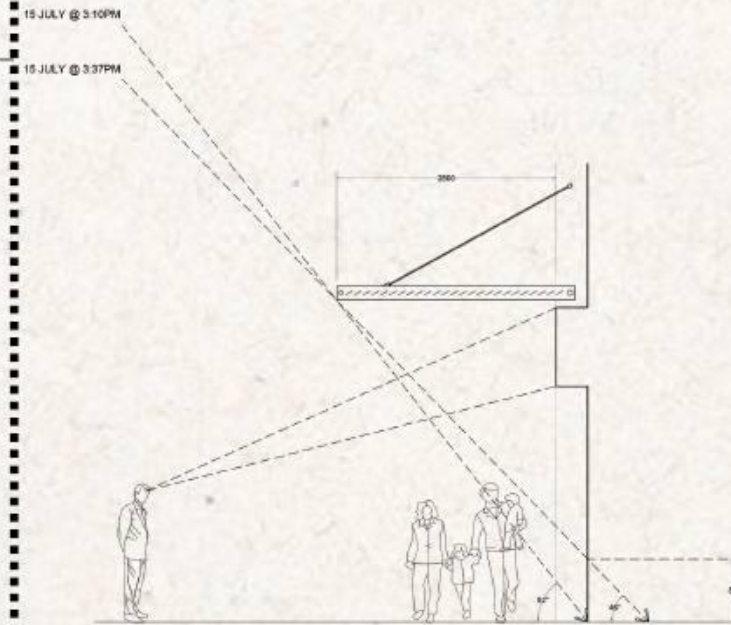
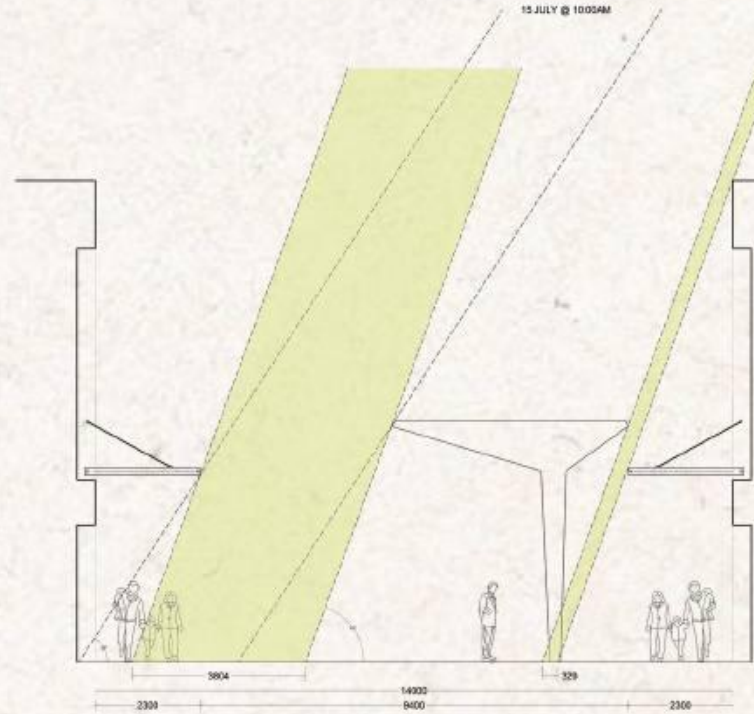
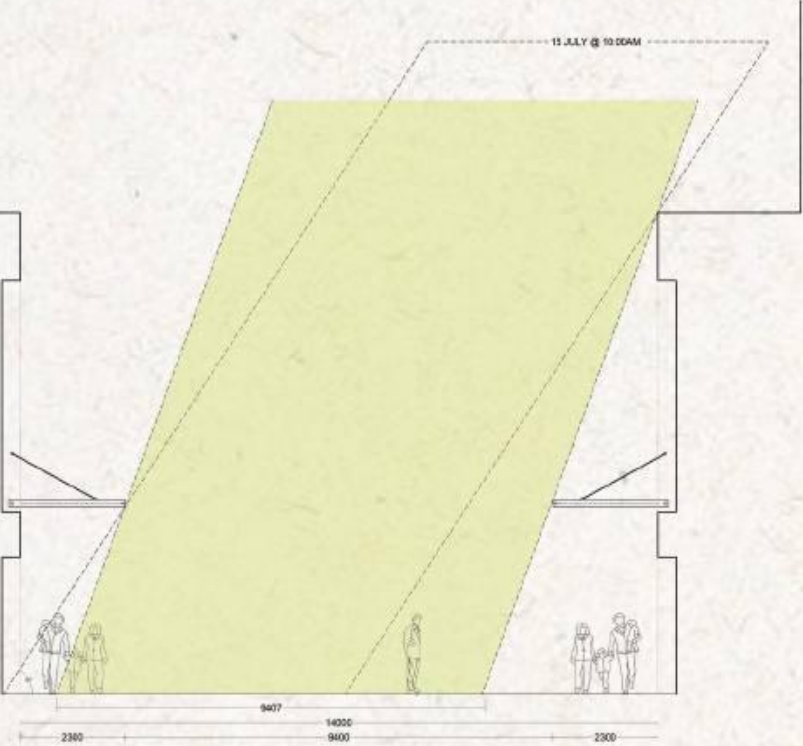
The primary objective was to enhance pedestrian comfort and provide relief from the harsh summer climate.

To achieve this, shading structures were introduced as extensions of the existing shopfronts, complemented by pergola elements along pedestrian pathways.

Strategic landscaping and planter features were incorporated to improve the visual appeal and create a more inviting public realm.

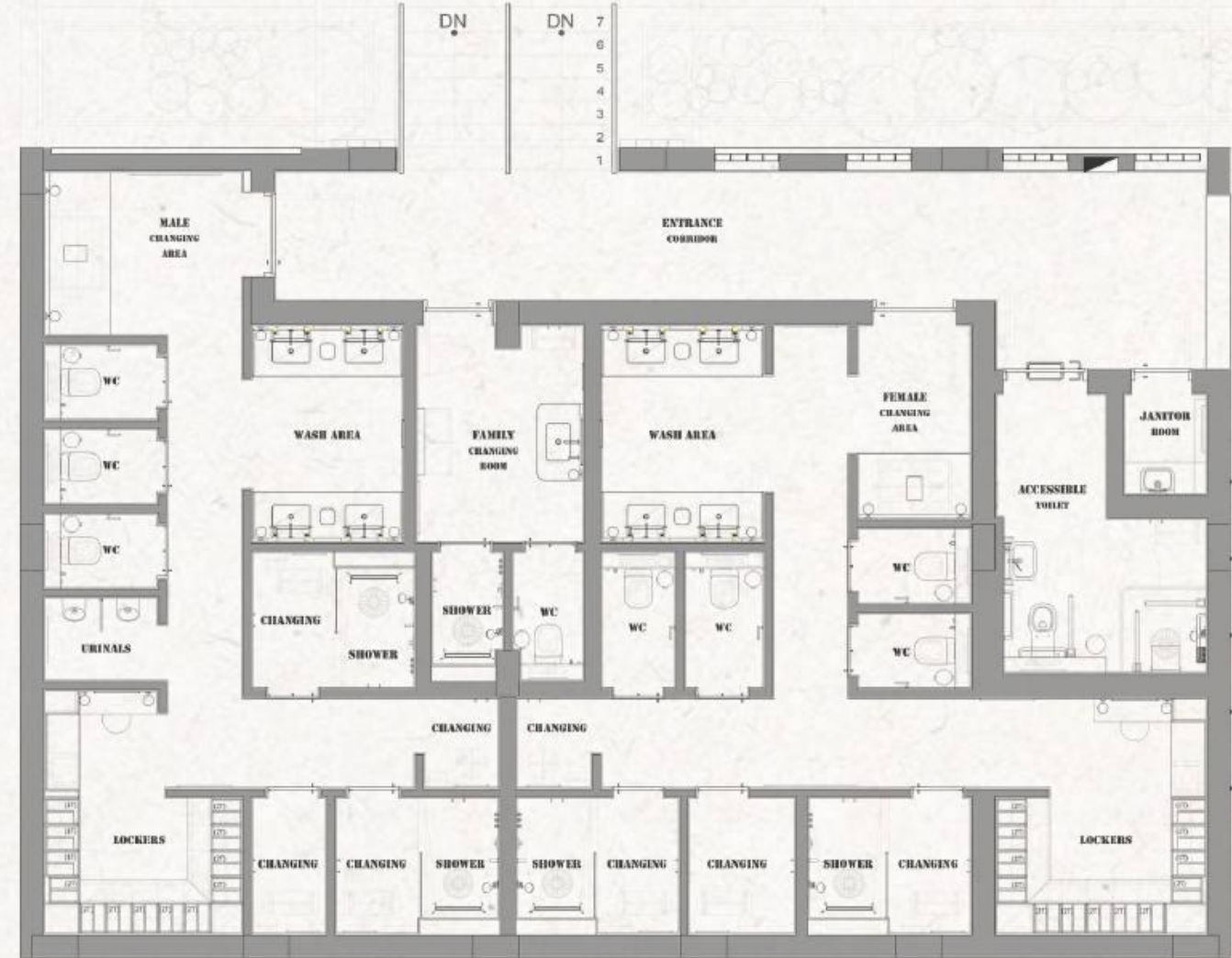
The role involved coordinating with material suppliers and joinery teams, ensuring the execution matched the approved design, and adapting details to suit site conditions.
